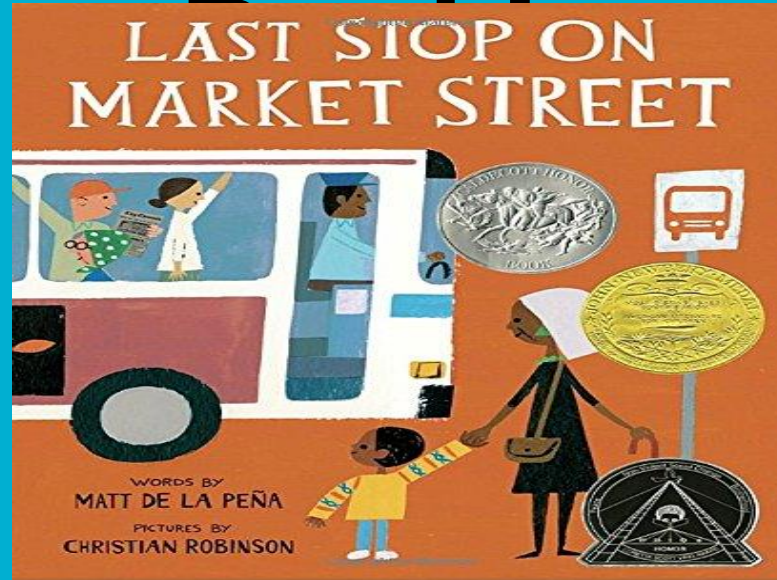

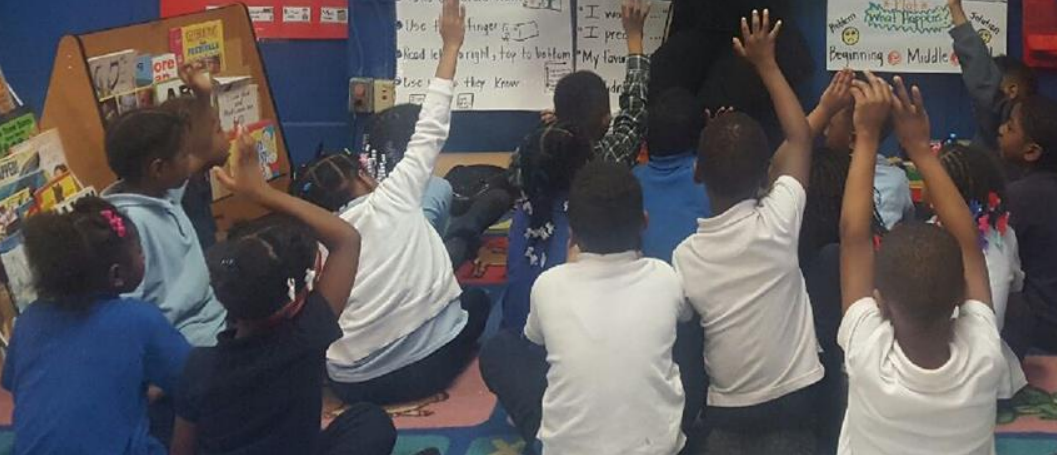

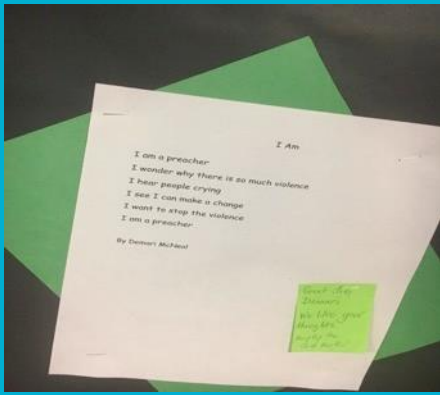

Last Stop On Market Street

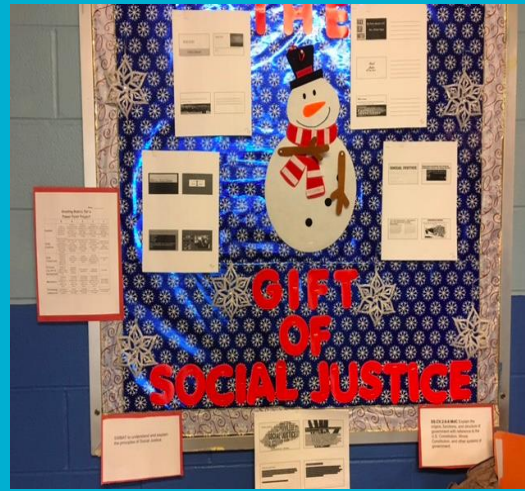

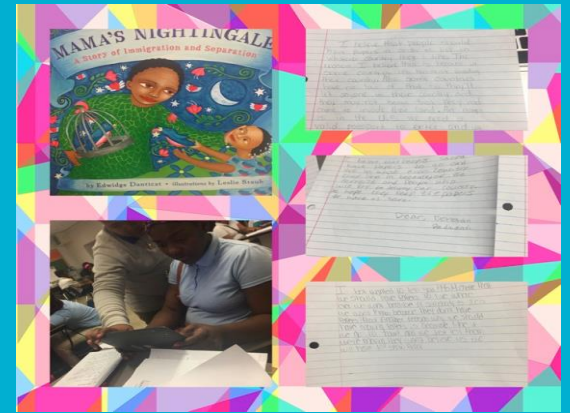
What I noticed was the bus talking and people walking and high schools talking to me and people bring gifts and people on the bus and people getting and I made me feel happy!
